Dr. Roberto Miguel Rodriguez is a professor of education and international administration at EUCLID (Pôle Universitaire Euclide / Euclid University).

During the 1970s, he also served as Ambassador for a Latin American country in Cairo, Egypt.

He holds a Ph.D. in Educational Policy and Administration from the University of Minnesota (1998), and a Juris Doctor from Northwestern California School of Law (2006).

Roberto is the living embodiment of the ideal of lifelong learning. He also holds Master degrees from the University of Minnesota (Business Administration, 1981; Business Taxation, 1992; Public Health, 1993; Education, 1994; Arts: Educational Policy and Administration, 1995; Liberal Arts, 1997; Agriculture, 2005); the University of Saint Thomas (Software Systems, 2002); Iowa State University of Science and Technology (Professional Agriculture, 2002); Americus (Economics, 2003); the University of the State of New York (Liberal Studies, 2003); California State University Dominguez Hills (Humanities, 2004; Negotiation, Conflict Resolution and Peacebuilding, 2009); Athabasca University in Canada (Integrated Studies, 2004; Distance Education, 2009); Texas Christian University (Liberal Arts, 2006), Central Michigan University (Science in Administration, 2007); the University of Alabama (Human Environmental Sciences – Interactive Technology, 2007); Novus Law School (Legal Letters, 2007); American Military University

He is currently pursuing a Doctorate in Political Science at SMC University (Switzerland) and a Master of Laws in International Business Law at the University of Liverpool (United Kingdom). He speaks Spanish, French, Portuguese, and Russian.

In 2009, he completed his DDIA with EUCLID and co-authored the book *Japan on the Edge: An Inquiry Into the Japanese Government's Struggle for Superpower Status and UN Security Council Membership at the Edge of Decline*. In 2010, he also received a specialized Master's Degree in Diplomacy from the University of Malta, with a thesis dealing with UN Security Council reform process.

He is a member of Golden Key International Honor Society, the Alpha Epsilon Lambda of the University of Alabama, the National Scholars Honor Society, The Honor Society of Agriculture Gamma Sigma Delta, and others. He received the Capps Capozzolo Award for Academic Excellence from University of Southern Colorado, the American Medal of Honor from the American Biographical Institute; and the International Peace Prize from the United Cultural Convention in Washington, DC.
